Unregistered Suffolks

Do you own purebred Suffolks that have not been registered and have previously not been eligible for your pedigree flock?

If the answer is yes and

1. You use a registered ram
2. Your flock is inspected by a Society Inspector

then the progeny of all approved ewes is considered pure and eligible for registration in the Flock Book.

You can also grade up to registered status by using registered Suffolk rams and having the offspring included in a supplementary register until they are 7/8ths pedigree, at which point they can be entered in the main section of the Flock Book. Please contact the Ballymena office for further details.

Once your flock is registered, your Suffolks are eligible for:

- Entry in Society Sales
- Entry in classes for registered breeders at Shows
- Inclusion in Society recording schemes
