

Carlisle Suffolk Sale Report

Shearling Gimmers

The first prize and Champion female came from the Thrunton pen of JHC Campbell & Sons from Northumberland. This Williamsgill Spitfire sired daughter out of a Drimmie Denman ewe went on to make 780gns. The same pen also produced the highest priced gimmer which sold for 1,000gns. This one was sired by Birness Kauto Star out of a Plasllewelyn Treble Chance.

S& G Brown had the 2nd prize gimmer which sold for 820gns. This ewe was sired by Pennan Finale and was out of a dam by Howeburn Last laugh.

Ewe Lambs

The first prize ewe lamb and Reserve Female Champion was brought forward from RD Williams from Denbighshire. This was a daughter of Lindum Long Run out of a Strathisla Scooby ewe and sold for 600gns. Second prize went to S&G Brown for a Pennan Finale daughter out of a Cairnton Contepomi ewe. It was sold for 500gns.

Aged Rams

Baileys Bugattie was the highest priced aged ram which was sold by Helen Somerville. This Rhaeadr Rossi son out of a Cairness Tremendous ewe. He sold for 900gns.

Shearling Rams

HM Martindale had the 1st prize shearling ram which sold for 1,800gns. This ram was sired by Landale Black Magic out of a ewe by Cairness Rossi. S&G Brown brought had the 2nd prize shearling ram which sold for 900gns. This ram was sired by Howeburn Last Laugh out of a ewe by Howeburn Captain.

Ram Lambs

The first prize ram lamb, male and supreme champion came from the Cairnton flock of JA Gibb. This ram was sired by Thurston Grand Diamond and was out of a Cairness Creation II. After some furious bidding this lamb was sold to Ross Lawrence, Devon for 2,800gns.

Second highest at the sale came for Lot 504 when a lamb from the Jubilee flock of Mark Evans was sold for 2,500gns to R Gray Langside. This ram was sired by Strathisla Seville and out of a ewe by Everton Forever. It was a good day for Mark when another Seville son caught the eye of Derbyshire breeder Steve Buckley who paid 1,100gns for Lot 506. This one is out of a Strathisla Shirocco ewe.

There were two lots that made 1,200gns. The first was Lot 578 which was the last lamb in from the pen of M Evans, Rhaeadr flock. J Douglas was the final bidder for this son of Broomknowes Kelso the Best out of a ewe by Rhaeadr Rossi. Lot 596 also made 1,200gns for D Jones, Thurston flock. This lamb was sired by Cairness Liam and out of a ewe sired by Muireisk King of Diamonds and sold to SD White, Steel Hall, Hexham.

Lot 637 exhibited by P Machray was the only other lot to breach the four figure mark when he sold for 1,000gns. This son of Middlemuir Messi and out of a ewe by Colessie Cut Above heads for use in the Stockton flock belong to J Sinnett.

There were two lots sold for 850gns. The first of these came from well known Lincolnshire breeder Sandy Fraser. This was a son of Glenhead Infusion and out of a ewe by Thurston Chieftain. Lot 498 also made 850gns for JT Cannon when he sold a son of Cairness Just the Best out of a ewe by Langside Lightening. He heads for use in the Capielaw flock of S&G Brown.
