

CARLISLE SUFFOLK IN LAMB SHOW & SALE

November 4, 2016

It was a lamb from the last consignment to enter the ring that made the top price of the day at the Annual Suffolk in lamb show and sale. Pamela Lupton's ewe lamb from her Kexbeck flock and by Rhaeadr Reggie I, out of a Rhaeadr Skyfall daughter was bid to 2,000gns and eventually knocked down to MA Evans, Tay-Yr-Accar, Denbigh.

The next best price at 800gns was a shearling gimmer from Lilburn Estates Farming Partnership. Sired by Rugley Stan and out of a homebred ewe by Essie Pendleton this gimmer who had been 2nd in her class at the pre-sale show was purchased by Stewart Craft to join his Lomondview flock based in Fife.

Lilburn Estates were also responsible for two gimmers selling at 600gns. Both of these were sired by Drimmie Upstart and had been scanned in lamb to Rookery Union Jack. They were both purchased by A & A Drummond, Nether Heilar Farm, Ayrshire who also purchased another gimmer with similar breeding from the same vendor at 550gns.

The Overall Champion at the morning's show was a shearling gimmer from James Cannon's Redbrae flock based near Wigtown. Sired by Birness Blockbuster, she has been scanned in lamb to Deveronside Dare Devil and was also knocked down to Stewart Craft.
