PEDIGREE SALES – SUFFOLK SHEEP

Regular consignors to the Suffolk in lamb show and sale held at Carlisle, Lilburn Estates Farming Partnership, secured the top price of 1,600gns for a gimmer G34:13:087.

This was a daughter of the great Forkins Figo ram and was out of a Roseden Houdini sired mother. This gimmer sold in lamb to Rookery Union Jack and was purchased by TA Blair of Thornton-Cleveleys for his Thornfleet flock based in Lancashire.

Ayrshire breeder William Borthwick of the Ballochmyle flock, Mauchline sold his Supreme Champion entry from the pre-sale judging for 1,400gns. This was a ewe lamb, PCA:14:00097, is a daughter of Rhaeadr Neymar and carries both Strathisla and Pexhill breeding on her mothers line. She sold the judge, James Wallace for his Claycrop at Kirkinner, Newton Stewart.

Also from the Ballochmyle pen of Mr Borthwick, another ewe lamb sold this time for 900gns. This was also a Rhaeadr Neymar sired daughter and her dam line includes Cairness Almighty The Second and Crosemanor Commandeur. She is sister to the flocks show gimmer this season and was purchased by M Radford of the Underhurth flock from Barnard Castle.

Also selling for 900gns was a three crop ewe offered by Tom Fitzsimon of the Sunnyhills flock based near Dumfries. This Silton Supreme daughter, NCK:11:001, is out of a Glenhead Goodbye bred mother and sold in lamb to Stockton Stirling. She was knocked down to D & S Smith & Son of Turnberry, Girvan for their Borreraig flock.
