

## **On Farm Sale Report**

Hans Porksen's sale of High Index rams on Friday the 26 August at Gallowshill, Cambo, Northumberland was attended by a large number of buyers from the North of England and Scotland.

Shearling rams from the "Wallington" Texel flock averaged £ 943 with a top of £1200 for a Wallington Pioneer son with a record muscle EBV of 5.84mm and an index of 374. He went to Alnham in the Cheviot Hills. Highest price from the "Hans" Suffolk flock was £1350 for a Sandyknowe Ettrick 07 son, with an index of £4.78, who went into the Borders. The Suffolk rams averaged £820. Most of the highest indexed animals, genetically in the top 1% of their breed went into Scotland. Suffolk shearling females sold to a top of £ 750 and averaged £ 585. Clearance was 66%.
